

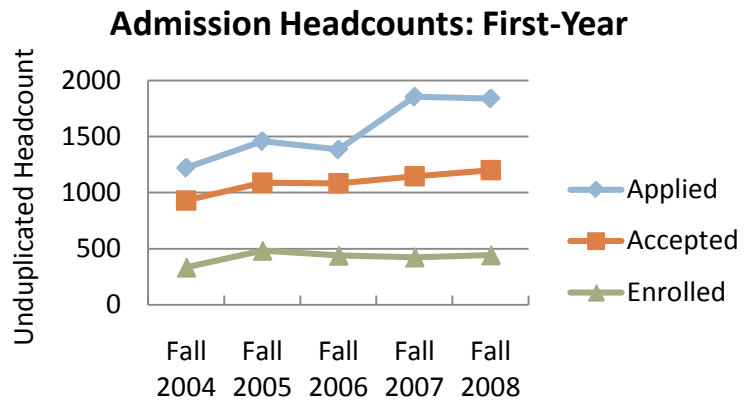
SAINT VINCENT COLLEGE FACT BOOK HIGHLIGHTS 2008-2009

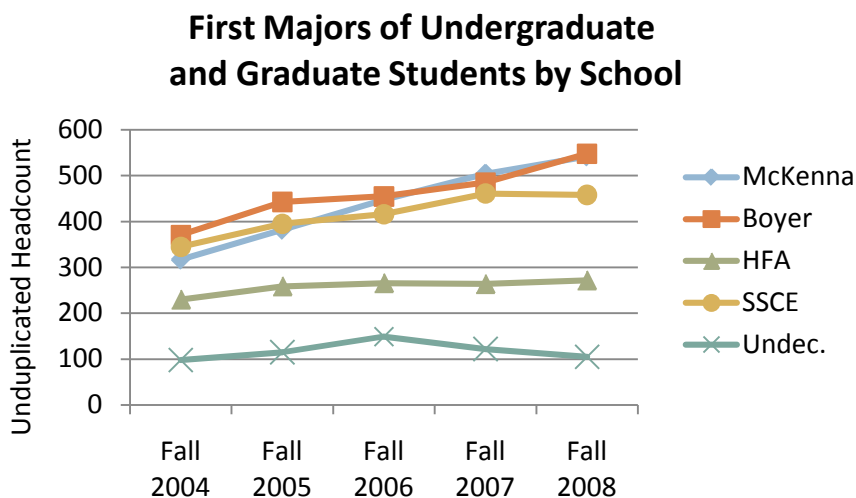
Applications have increased 51% over the past five years, and 158% over the past ten years.

Fall 2008 had the largest undergraduate and graduate populations to date.

Approximately 60% of undergraduate students are residents of Westmoreland or Allegheny counties. Roughly 11% of undergraduate students are from out of state.
