Guest Parking

All parking areas will be open to the public. Members of the public safety staff will be directing traffic to appropriate parking areas. A shuttle service will be in operation throughout the day.



Parking for those with special accommodations is available. The public safety staff will direct guests in possession of a state-issued handicapped placard or a Commencement 2025 Special Accommodations parking pass to the assigned area. There will be a special needs drop-off area located outside of the Carey Center – please watch for signs. This area is designed for easy access to the gymnasium by use of an elevator. Guests not in possession of a state-issued handicapped placard, plate or ID will be directed to a parking area with golf cart shuttle service. Golf cart shuttles are for the use of those who need assistance only.

Families and guests are urged to arrive in time to be seated by 10:45 a.m. The procession will begin promptly at 11 a.m. Ushers will be available to assist with seating.

Guest Seating Cont.

Please refrain from bringing unnecessary items (large packages, backpacks, etc.) to the ceremony. Safety precautions may necessitate the random search of suspicious items. All aisles must remain clear at all times. There will be a designated area to store strollers during the ceremony. Please see an usher for directions. For the safety of our graduates, access to the stage as well as to the aisles in the faculty/graduate section will be restricted during the conferral of degrees.

Photography

The Grad Team will be the official photographer for Commencement at Saint Vincent College. This photographer is the only person with clear access to the stage. Each graduate will be photographed individually before crossing the stage and when receiving their diploma.
