

# RETURN TO CAMPUS: SPRING 2021

We look forward to welcoming all our students back to Saint Vincent College!

In an effort to keep you safe during COVID-19, we are making adjustments to the return to campus process for the spring 2021 semester. Prior to your arrival, please review and adhere to all COVID-19 precautions and expectations set forth by the College. ## COVID-19 Clearance

**All resident and commuting students (both graduate and undergraduate)** must have COVID-19 clearance to be on campus for the start of the semester Feb. 8, 2021. COVID-19 clearance is obtained by either participating in the free on-campus testing or providing the documentation described below to [immunizations@stvincent.edu](mailto:immunizations@stvincent.edu) prior to returning to campus.

## On Campus Testing – Feb. 1, 2 and 3, 2021

In-state students will be offered on-campus testing. Resident students who elect to be tested will move-in and quarantine in their room until given the result of the test. They may leave their room to pick up meals and outdoor exercise. Commuting students should quarantine at home until they receive results.

On-campus COVID-19 PCR testing will be provided at the ground floor of the Rogers Center on Monday, Feb. 1 through Wednesday, Feb. 3. Testing is done by appointment and students should report directly to testing prior to moving-in or other campus activities. There are approximately 1,000 appointment opportunities over the three days. Appointments are available on a first-come, first-served basis. It is recommended that you make your appointment as soon as possible. ## Those Arriving from Outside Pennsylvania or Not Electing On-Campus Testing

Move-in for those who do not participate in on-campus testing will take place **Feb. 6 and 7, 2021**. Out-of-state and international students and all students who do not participate in the free on-campus testing must provide evidence of a negative PCR COVID-19 test administered within 72 hours of returning to campus. The College is not responsible for any costs associated with testing that is not covered under a student's insurance. Documentation must be emailed to [immunizations@stvincent.edu](mailto:immunizations@stvincent.edu) prior to returning to campus.

**Those who arrive without documentation of a COVID-19 PCR negative test will be required to quarantine following the protocols in the Health and Safety Plan.**

## Students Who Have Tested Positive for COVID-19 in the Last 90 Days or Received the Vaccination for COVID-19

Any student who had a positive COVID-19 test 90 days prior to returning to campus is not required to have another COVID-19 test. Documentation of the positive COVID-19 test must be emailed to [immunizations@stvincent.edu](mailto:immunizations@stvincent.edu) prior to returning to campus.

Any student who received a vaccination for COVID-19 prior to returning to campus should send documentation to [immunizations@stvincent.edu](mailto:immunizations@stvincent.edu) prior to returning to campus.

# RESIDENCE HALL MOVE-IN

- You are encouraged to sanitize your belongings or allow 72 hours before packing them to eliminate any possible contamination.
- We ask that you only use one person to assist you with move-in if absolutely necessary, and that person only enter to drop off belongings and to leave the building immediately.
- Please bring your own masks and other personal protective equipment. Masks are required to be worn in all public areas during move-in.
- You may only move back during your scheduled window of time, as listed below. Please plan to arrive during this time or you will be asked to wait for a time until we can assess the appropriate occupancy in the building.

## RECEIPT OF FINANCIAL CLEARANCE

All students who are financially cleared will receive notification on the portal.

Student bills are due on Jan. 15, 2021. The College will begin posting notifications for financially cleared students on Jan. 11 and will continue to do so over break. Financial clearance must be obtained prior to move-in and/or the start of classes.

## STUDENTS WITH COVID & FINANCIAL CLEARANCE

Students must have COVID and financial clearance to return to their residence hall rooms. COVID-19 clearance is obtained by participating in on-campus testing or providing the necessary documentation described above.

Check in with the residence hall staff in the lobby to receive your room key.

Residents may arrive on campus at the following designated times. Please communicate with your roommate prior to arrival to ensure there is no overlap in move-in times to avoid congestion.
