Arriving and Unloading

Transfer Move-in Day: Friday, August 28, 12-2 p.m.

- Once on campus, check in at the Welcome Booth for directions to your assigned residence hall. Please inform the attendant that you are a transfer student and provide the name of your residence hall.
- If you are a **varsity athlete**, check-in at the Fred Rogers Center next to Lot A to meet with the athletic training staff prior to moving into your residence hall.
- Once you arrive at your residence hall, check in with the prefect at the front desk who will provide you with your key and ID.
- Pull your vehicle up to the building and unload.
- Please move vehicles immediately after unloading in order to allow other vehicles to unload easily.

Late Arrivals

If you plan to arrive after 2:00 p.m., you should contact the Residence Life Office at residence.life@stvincent.edu to make arrangements for your arrival.

Parking Permits

If you plan to have a vehicle on campus, you must obtain a parking permit from the Public Safety Office. Submit your permit request online, and your permit will be delivered to your campus mailbox. Parking permits must be displayed in vehicles at all times. Vehicles without a valid permit will be subject to ticketing beginning the first week of classes.
