- Writing sample of 3-5 pages from a junior- or senior- level high school course
- Personal statement of no more than three printed pages or video of no more than five minutes responding to the provided prompt. **Prompt: Saint Vincent is a learning community based in academic rigor, service and personal/spiritual growth. How do you plan to contribute to our community during your time as a student?**
- Virtual interview with admission counselor or Dean of Admission
